Write an essay describing yourself. Discuss your background, experience, personal accomplishments, and extracurricular activities. Discuss the ideal job for yourself when you graduate. Describe your goals for yourself that you plan to achieve within the next 5 years, and also in the next 10 years. Also describe a life goal or accomplishment whether work or personal related. The essay should be a minimum of 500 words, but not more than 1,000 words. All documents should be in New Times Roman font 12 pt size, left justified, single spaced, one side printing.

Separate from the essay, please list any volunteer work you do or have participated in, any hobbies or personal interest. Finally, please include at least 3 references. These may be personal or employment related, but at least one must be employment related. Include name, contact information and your association with the reference.
